Colourful Festive Celebrations in May

Hong Kong does not only host our Forum in May, but also two very colourful Chinese festivals, they are the Cheung Chau Bun Festival and Birthday of Buddha.



Cheung Chau Bun Festival

is a traditional festival that takes place annually on the island of Cheung Chau. The tale dates back to the late Qing dynasty when a plague devastated the island until the islanders built an altar in front of the Pak Tai Temple (Temple of the Northern Emperor).

They paraded the deity around the island in an attempt to drive away evil spirits. Such rituals remain to this day. Every year, the islanders organise a weeklong celebration that includes two of the highlights: Floating Colours Parade and Bun Scrambling Competition. Customs are observed during the celebration and special vegetarian food is served.

The Birthday of Buddha falls on the 8th day of the fourth month in the lunar calendar. Legend has it that nine dragons sprayed water on the baby Buddha when he was born to give him a bath.

Today on Buddha's birthday, Buddhists in Hong Kong bathe his statues in bowls of water as a ritual they observe and one that is believed to be purifying to one's soul. Deliberately bitter in taste, special green cookies are eaten on the day to signify hardships being overcome to embrace the good future. These ancient rituals can be observed in Buddhist temples around Hong Kong but the most spectacular celebration can be found at the Po Lin Monastery on Lautau Island. Though an outlying island, Lantau is accessible not only by ferry but also by road and rail. The Po Lin Monastery can be reached by local bus as well as the quintessential Ngong Ping 360 Cable Car.
